WHY YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID?

Join the cadre of certified instructors in Maryland who help those who work with youth make a difference in their lives. Youth Mental Health First Aid, an 8- hour national certification course, teaches the skills needed to recognize the signs of a mental health or substance use problem or crisis identify community resources and link the young person to appropriate treatment and support resources.

WHAT DOES THETRAINING OVER?

- Common signs & symptoms in this age group, including:

 Anxiety
 - Depression
 - Eating Disorders
 - Attention Deficit Disorder (ADHD)
 - Substance Use
- How to help an adolescent who may be developing a mental health problem or may be in crisis
- How to connect the adolescent with help
